

Registration

- ☀ Prospectus & Registration forms for admission to the school can be obtained from the school office on cash payment.
- ☀ It should be duly filled and submitted with the required documents and certificates as mentioned in the form by stipulated date.
- ☀ The registered candidates will be called for an interaction / interview.
- ☀ Registration fee is non-refundable and registration is no guarantee of admission.

Interview / Admission

- ☀ Overall growth, observation self reliance are the main consideration for the admission.
- ☀ Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit.
- ☀ 5% seats are reserved for talented ST/SC students of the weaker section of the society.
- ☀ The Birth certificate from the competent authority, mark sheet, transfer certificate obtained from the previous school, medical fitness certificates & photographs are essential at the time of admission.
- ☀ Fees have to be deposited within seven days of selection, failing which the seat will be allotted to next wait listed candidate.

Progress Report

- ☀ Parents will be kept regularly informed by their wards, academic progress and participation in co-curricular activities.
- ☀ Four formative and two summative examinations are to be conducted during the academic year.
- ☀ Promotion is granted on the basis of whole years performance.

Attendance

- ☀ 75% attendance is essential for the promotion in the next higher class.
- ☀ In case of sickness, a medical certificate from registered medical practitioner has to be submitted.
- ☀ It is compulsory for a student to attend the school on the first and the last day before and after Summer Vacation, Pujā Vacation and Winter Vacation.

Withdrawals

- ☀ Withdrawals from any class must be preceded by a month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
- ☀ All due will have to be cleared before a Transfer Certificate is issued.
- ☀ Transfer Certificate will be issued after one week of receipt of the application.



Parents Teacher Meet

In order to establish a meaningful relationship between the school and the parents meeting are held on the second Saturday of every month to discuss the progress of each student.

School Session : 1st April to 31st March.

Eligibility : Children seeking admission to LKG and UKG should have attained the age 3 plus years and 4 plus years respectively as on 1st April in that year.

Guidelines for Students :

- ☀ All the students must possess school Text Books, School Diary & Stationery etc.
- ☀ Students must come to school in proper School Uniform.
- ☀ Students are expected to be clean, neat and tidy.
- ☀ Applications for leave must be submitted a day in advance and it should be counter signed by the parent / guardian.
- ☀ Students are advised not to bring valuable articles to the school.
- ☀ The school management will not be responsible for any such loss.
- ☀ Students are not allowed to leave the school during working hours.
- ☀ The school reserves the right to take severe action, even to strike off the name of the student from the school rolls, against the students who are found guilty of any misconduct.
- ☀ No pupil who fails for two years in succession will be kept in the school.
- ☀ Attendance in official school functions like the school day, Independence Day, Republic Day etc are compulsory.
- ☀ Absentees may be fined or penalized.
- ☀ School Bus boarders must follow the regulations of the school transport. They must follow the instructions of the driver and the conductor.



Personal File

The school maintains an individual file for all the children to have systematic record for the academic as well as curricular progress and achievements.

Identity Card

An Identity Card bearing a passport size photograph and information of student will remain in his / her custody all the time.

Transport Facility

- ☀ All bus charges must be paid in advance by the 15th of every month for which payment is due.
- ☀ One month bus fee is charged for May and June. Bus fee once paid will not be refunded on any account.
- ☀ If a parent wants to take his child with him during the school hours, he must inform the concerned bus staff or the bus in-charge about it.
- ☀ If for any reason whatsoever, the school decides to cancel or change any route of the school bus, the parents shall have no objection to it and will make their own arrangement of conveyance for their children.
- ☀ In case of sudden closure of the school, the buses will not ply.

Guidelines for Parents

Do's

- ☀ Use the school diary as a means of communication with class teacher and check the diary for Home Work and the teacher remarks, if any.
- ☀ Sign the test copies / papers as and when sent home.
- ☀ See that your ward has all the text books, items of stationary, craft materials etc. right in the beginning of the session.
- ☀ Ensure that all the books and note books are covered with brown paper with all the necessary information written there on.
- ☀ Ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform with polished shoes, trimmed hair and clean nails.
- ☀ Send the children regularly and punctually to school. No absence will be permitted without a leave application. Late comer will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- ☀ Both the parents must attend the parent-teacher meet.
- ☀ Pay the fees as per schedule.
- ☀ Intimate the school in case of change in address / telephone number.
- ☀ Please respond only when there is a written advice from school authorities on any matter.
- ☀ Parents / guardians are expected to report carefully and see that their wards make a special effort to study those subjects in which they are weak.
- ☀ If a child is withdrawn from the school, transfer certificate should be taken. School fee will be collected until the T.C. is taken and it is taken in the middle of the month, full fee for the month will be charged.

Don'ts

- ☀ Do not send the child to school in case of an infectious disease and medical certificate should be furnished from a medical authority at the time of rejoining the school after illness.
- ☀ Do not walk into the class room or meet the teacher in the class room. Please see the teacher with prior appointment through Principal.
- ☀ Do not visit the teachers at their residence.
- ☀ Do not send money or valuable articles with your wards. School takes no responsibility for any loss.
- ☀ Parents are expected not enter the school to speak with the teachers during class hours. Those who seek information or want to register a complaint should do so to the Principal. No school business will transacted during holidays.
